As you may know, charities can benefit if those members who are taxpayers sign a Gift Aid Declaration form; HMRC give us 25% of your subscription and it costs you nothing. So if your total income exceeds the minimum amount at which income tax is levied (£7,475 for those under 65, £9,940 for those over 65 and £10,090 for those over 75), signing this declaration now will benefit us greatly.
